FIRST AID ON SITES

- Marisco is legally obliged to ensure sufficient first aid is provided on every site it operates.
- Marisco aims to fulfil its first aid legal obligation by:
 - Ensuring at least 20% of its workforce and all of its field managers are first aid qualified at any one time, and will offer first aid courses to all staff member at least once a year.
 - Marisco offers certified first aid training to all employees through the Atlas Training Library.
 - Marisco issues personal first aid kits to every remote worker. They then become responsible for ensuring it is carried with them onto site at all times, and the kit is regularly replenished with items they feel they need, including eye wash ampules, haemostatic dressings and tourniquets.
- Make sure you add the contacts of the first aiders listed below to your phone directory. If you are injured and require first aid
- Employees are encouraged to read the **emergency procedures** to be followed in the event of an accident on our website (www.mariscosouth.com/emergency). People fall ill or can suffer a serious accident at any time. What you read there today could save someone's life tomorrow.
- Although one can see why the Ambulance Service sometimes make public appeals to only call them in a 'real' emergency, the biggest mistake you can make is delaying that 999 call in an incident. A casualty with a cut that has nicked a main artery can bleed out and die within a matter of minutes if no attempt is made to pack the wound and apply pressure to stem the flow. Calling 999 immediately and wishing you hadn't wasted their time, is a better alternative to watching a casualty die because you hesitated to make the call and the emergency services arrived too late to save them.

Should you attempt to render first aid to a casualty if you are not first aid trained? If the casualty is not in danger of dying, call and wait for a qualified first aider or the emergency services to arrive.

If the casualty is unconscious and has stopped breathing or you can see blood pumping out of a wound, then you are probably the only hope they have of survival. Could you live with yourself if they died and you had not made any attempt to save them? To help make the decision easier, you will have the un-dying gratitude of those you help, and no one has been prosecuted in the UK for making a genuine attempt to save life and failing to do so.
